
RED RIBBON CLUB

Red Ribbon Club of Aiman College of Arts and Science for Women organized A One Day Virtual Awareness Program on 'Celebrating Life: Developing Life Skills to Prevent HIV Infection'. J.Sandhiya Lakshmi from II AFT, the Joint Secretary of RRC welcomed the participants and introduced the chief guest. The first session was handled by the Guest of Honor Mrs.Pushpalatha, District Supervisor, District AIDS Control Unit, Collector Office, Trichy. The speaker explained the obstacles faced by AIDS survivors and strongly insisted the young people should recognize the effort that is needed in this hour to help and achieve AIDS free generation. She also emphasized the importance of protected sex, safe and appropriate use of injections, reducing unnecessary transfusion, routine HIV Antibody Screening Interventions.

The second session commenced with the key note address of Mrs.B.John Mary, ICTC Counsellor, Inamkulathur PHC, Trichy. The speaker elucidated the roles and responsibilities of RRC and briefed the main concepts of RRC, 'Not me but you'. She highlighted the four roots of HIV transmission: unprotected blood transmission, unsterilization of syringe, mother to child transmission and unprotected sex. The program covered the prevention of HIV with the help of antiretroviral therapy, Nevirapine Syrup and through the mode of counseling and prescribing nutritional diets.

The speaker pointed out the foolish belief of HIV spreading by means of embracing, holding, shaking hands, coughing, sharing public toilets or sharing clothes, attending same schools and working together. She concluded by stating the importance of celebrating AIDS Day to bring change in the society by informing individuals and at the same time providing a loving and caring atmosphere for those affected by this disease. The event came to an end with a vote of thanks by the Vice President of RRC, M.Afraah Sheik of II CS.

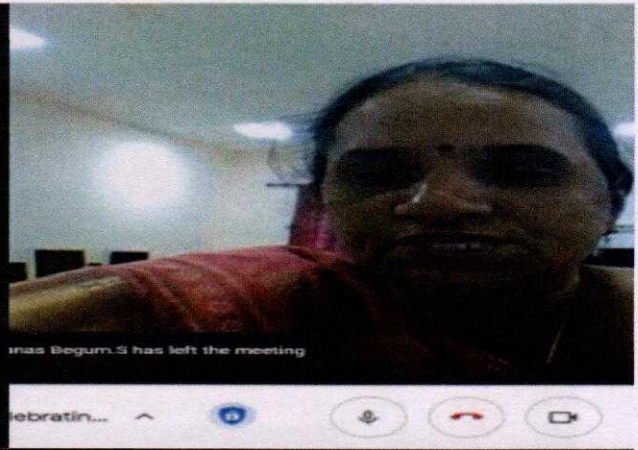

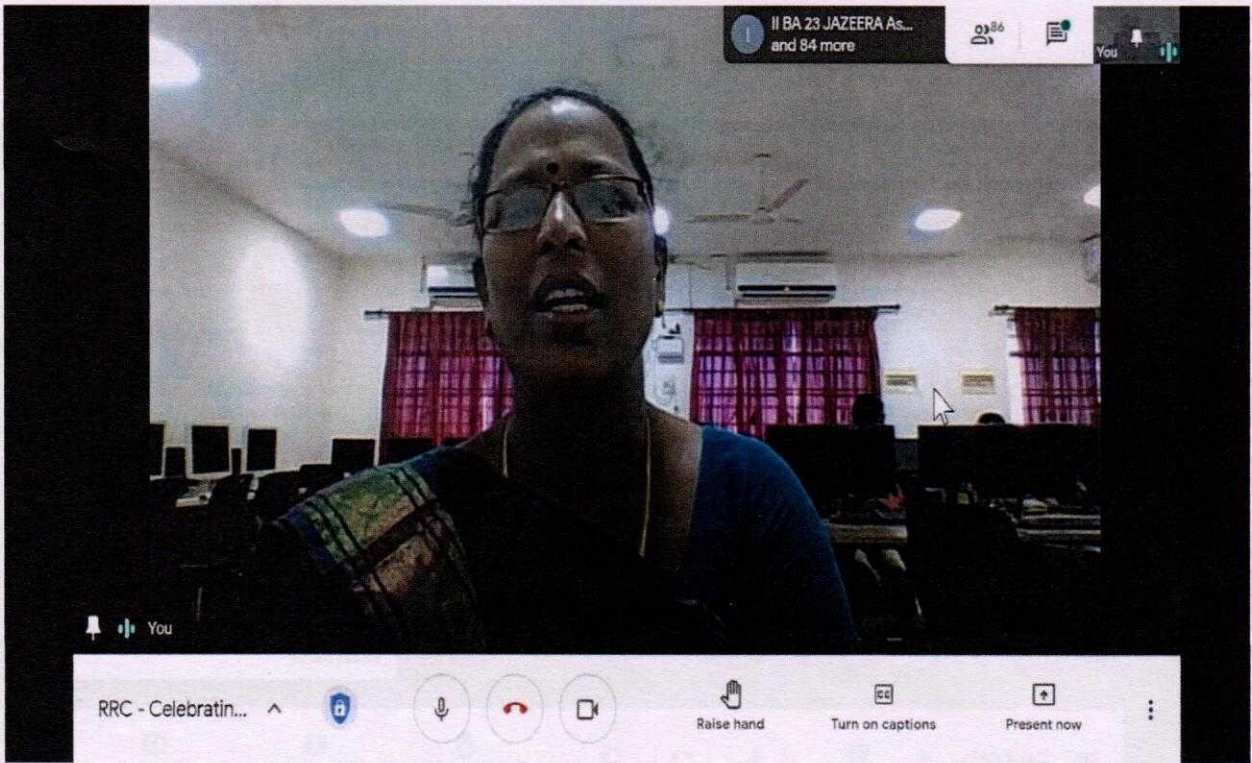
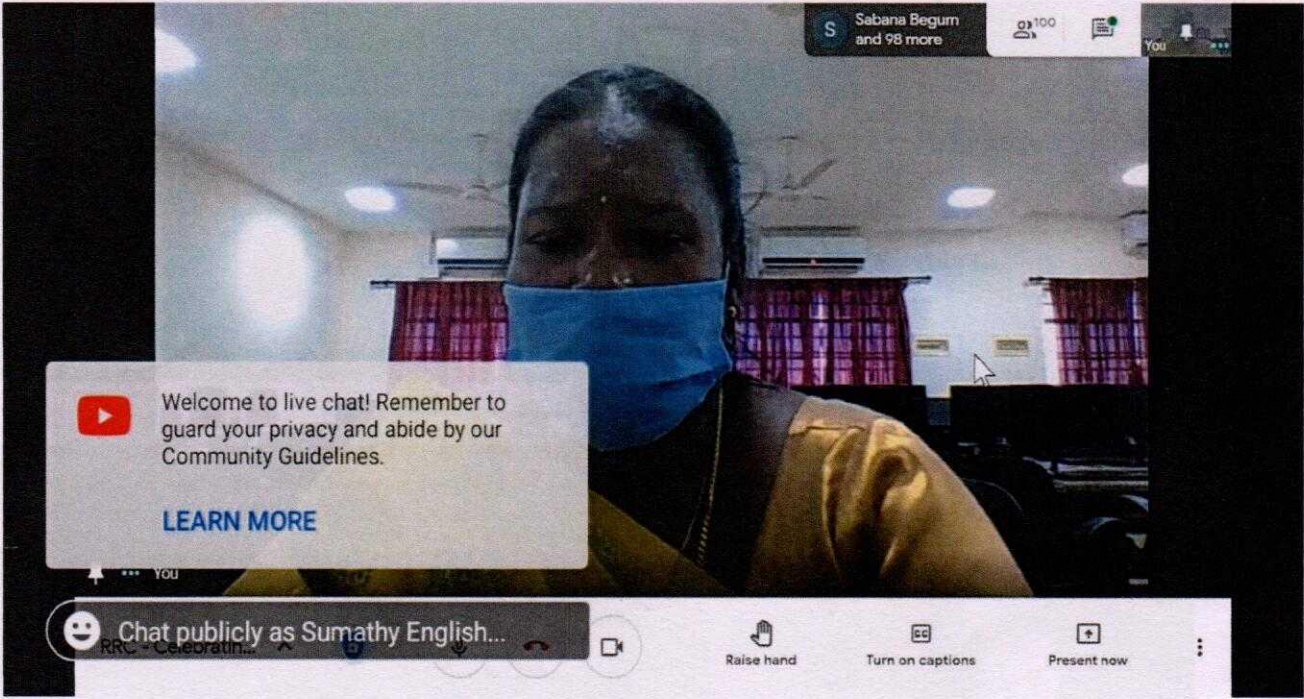
