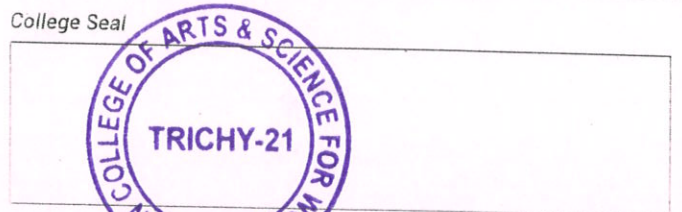

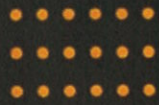

Mr. Prashant Ganesh, DevOps, Team Lead, RFPIO Inc., Founder at Athleap Coimbatore detailed regarding Interpersonal skills, Interpersonal skills which is —also known as people skills or Soft Skills which we used to communicate with and understand others. We use these skills daily when interacting with people face-to-face. Examples of interpersonal skills include: Active listening, Teamwork, Responsibility, Dependability, Leadership, Motivation, Flexibility, Patience, Empathy, Conflict resolution, Negotiation etc.

Many interpersonal skills involve communication. That communication can be verbal—such as persuasion or tone of voice—or nonverbal—such as listening and body language. Interpersonal skills are important for communicating and working with groups and individuals in your personal and professional life. People with strong interpersonal skills tend to build good

relationships and can work well with others. They understand family, friends, coworkers and clients well. People often enjoy working with colleagues who have good interpersonal skills.

Many employers try to hire staff with strong interpersonal skills because these individuals often work well on teams and collaborate with their colleagues effectively. People with interpersonal skills also tend to make good leaders because of their ability to communicate with and motivate those around them.

Mr. Prashant Ganesh emphasized that students to follow the following:

Nine tips to improve Interpersonal Skills

1. Cultivate a positive outlook.
2. Control your emotions.
3. Acknowledge others' expertise.
4. Show a real interest with your friends/classmates.
5. Find one good trait in every individual.
6. Practice active listening.
7. Be assertive.
8. Practice empathy.
9. Maintain relationships.

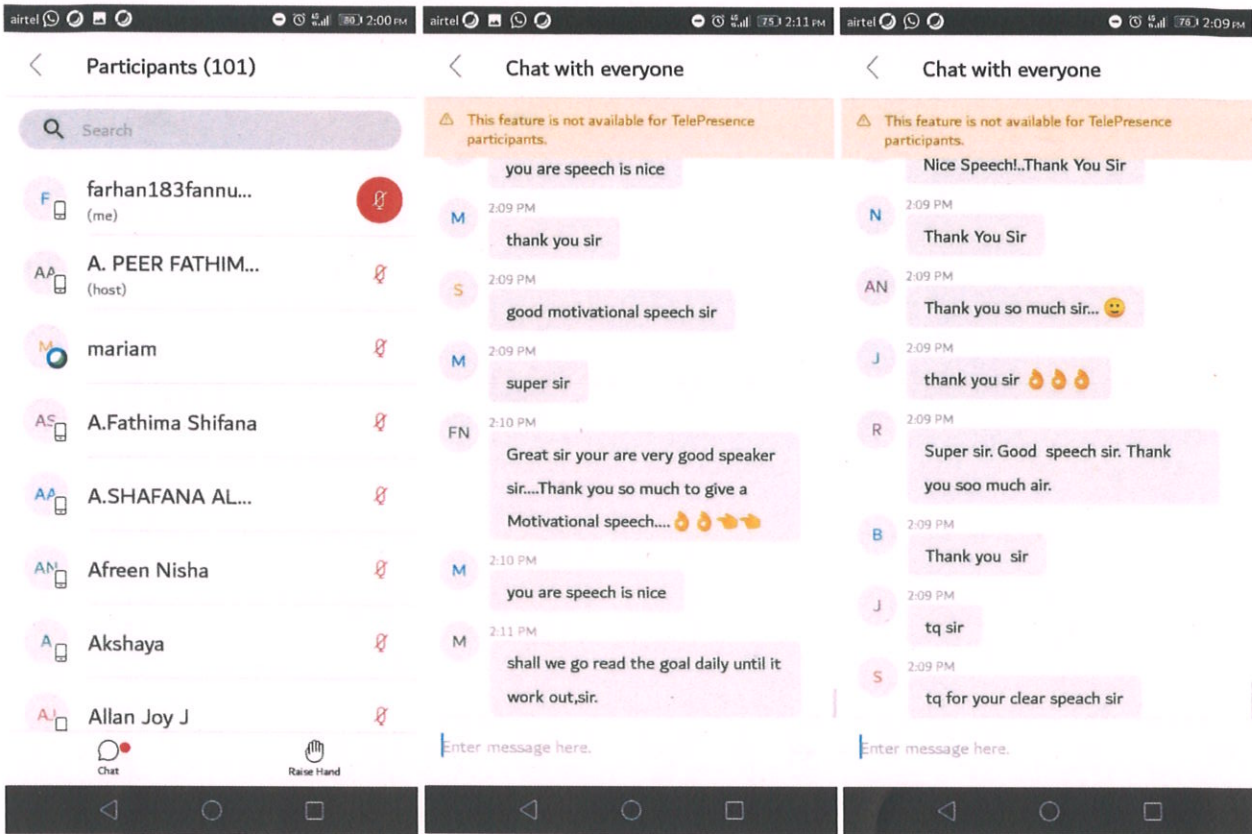
