The cold climate of the hills was refreshing. The students were excited by the changing flora of the forest at different altitudes as their buses made their way through the winding roads and hair pin bends. The gentle warmth of the Sun was welcomed by the students. The surrounding greenery packed with cloudless sky fascinated them and brought within them an appreciation of Nature. 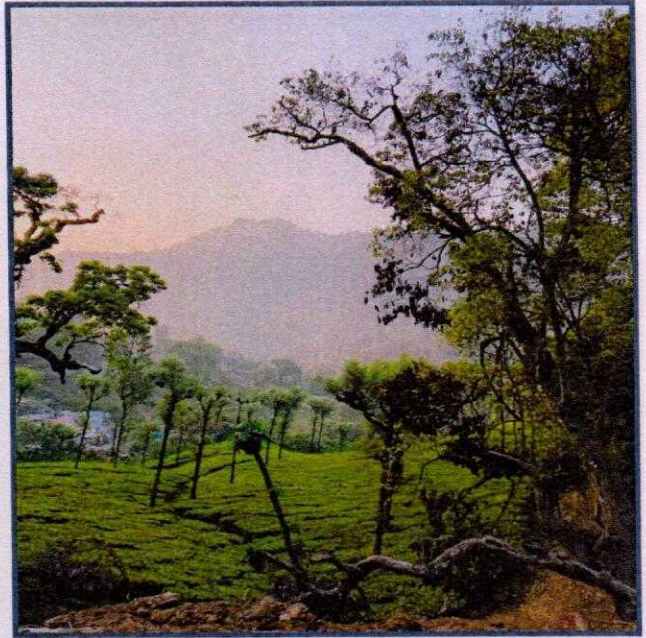

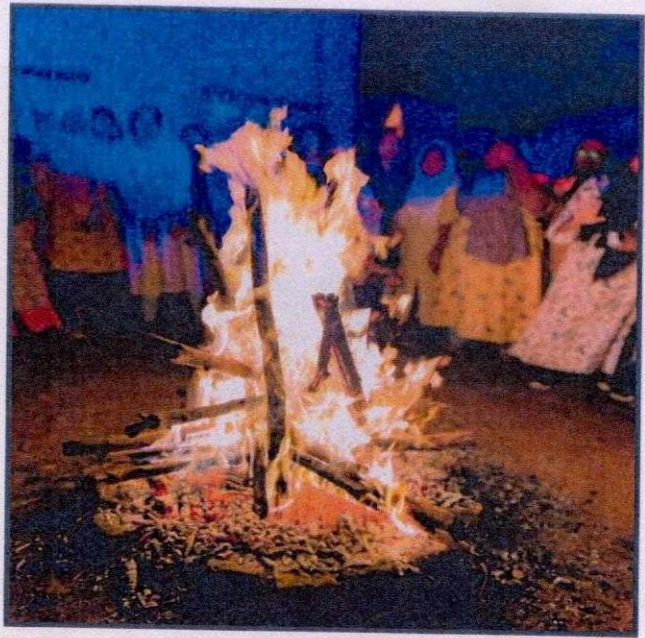

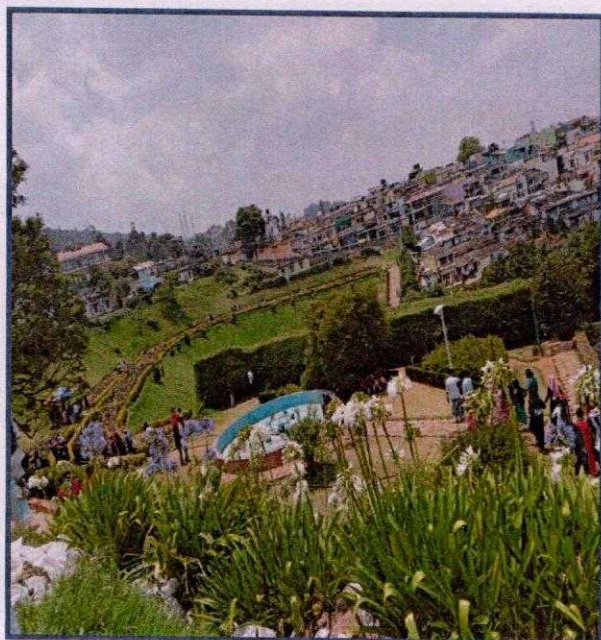

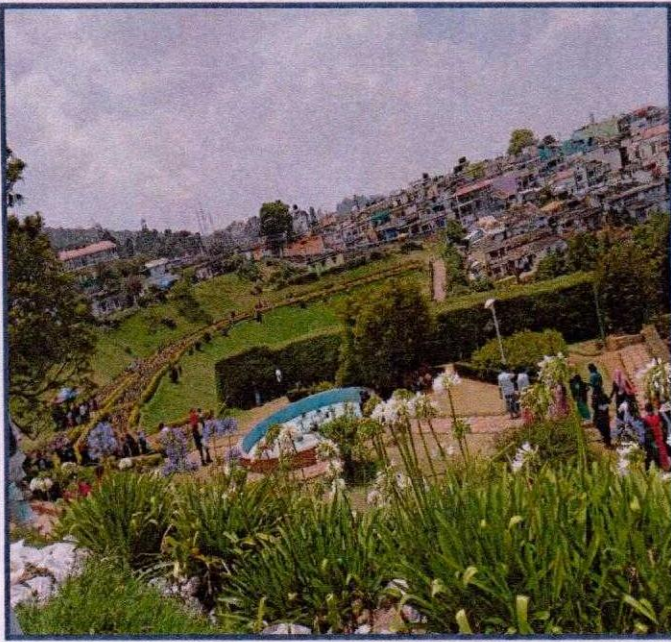

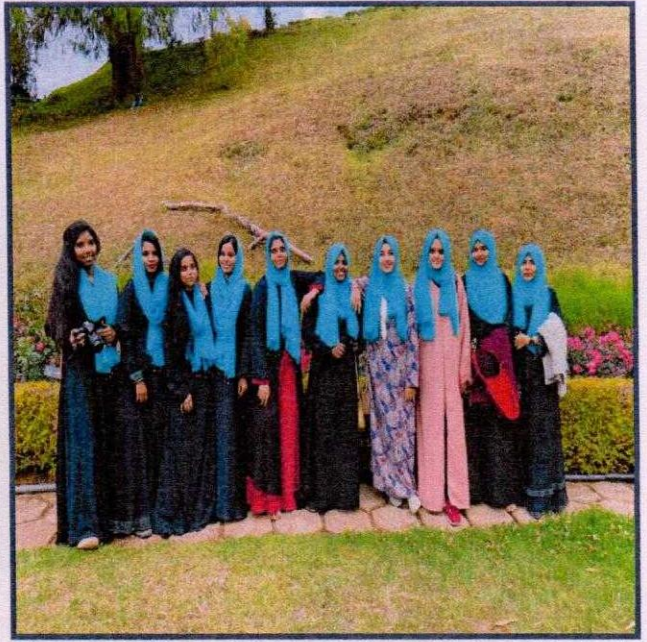

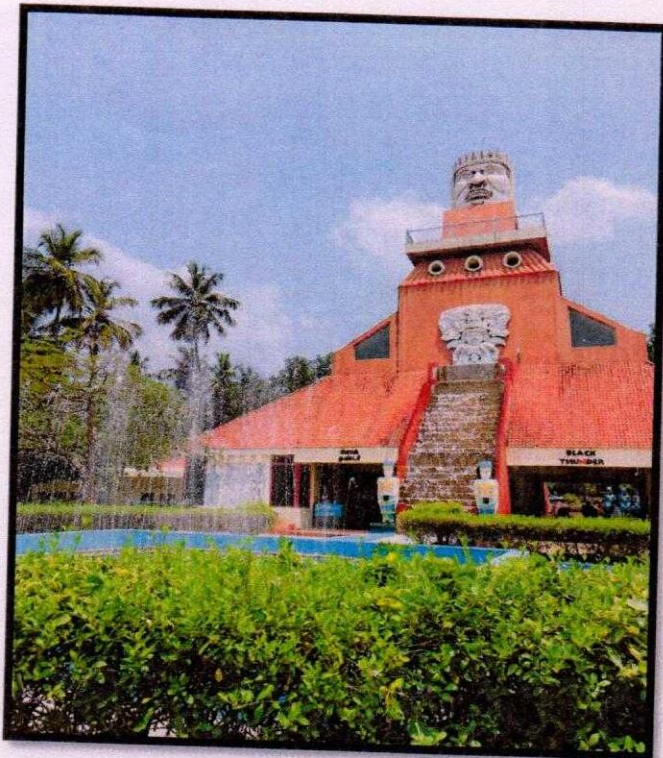

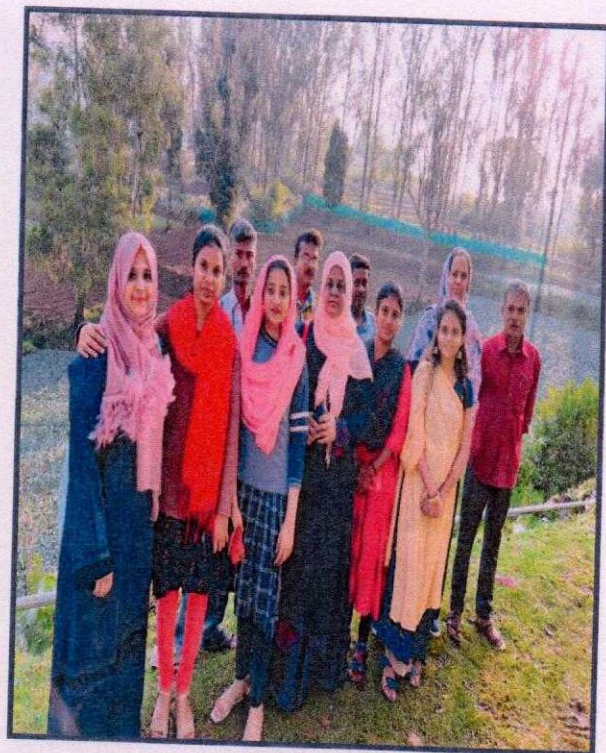
